This is a Call for Applications about a special opportunity to apply for Fellowships for a three-week summer workshop on alternative academic careers in Chicago in 2016. This opportunity is part of the Humanities Without Walls Consortium, funded by a grant from the Andrew W. Mellon Foundation, and based at the Illinois Program for Humanities Research at UIUC. Each Fellow will receive a stipend of \$4,500 for travel and living expenses in Chicago, and a certificate of completion upon graduating from the summer workshop.
